ASB Case Management (1 day)

Review the basics of case management. Learn how to:

- open cases effectively
- manage risk
- deal with complainants and perpetrators
- construct effective action plans
- gather evidence and effective investigation techniques
- deal with counter allegations
- close cases effectively.

Safeguarding Vulnerable Adults and Children (1 day)

- listening to up-to-date guidance on current legislation (The Care Act and The Children's Act)
- learning how to spot tell-tale signs of abuse
- learning how to make referrals to statutory agencies
- learning how to challenge partner agencies

- your powers within the ASB, Crime and Policing Act 2014
- what your powers mean in practice by exploring insightful case studies
- by group discussion around the practical approaches to applying these powers to your business.

Community MARAC and Partnership Approaches (1 day)

Learn how to tackle even the most difficult cases by problem solving effectively. You will:

- examine how Community MARAC's have helped problem-solve complex cases using a partnership approach
- review and take home bespoke reference materials so that you can set up Community MARAC's in your area.

A Step by Step Approach in Delivering an ASB Strategy Training for Managers (1 day)

With the increased focus on Value for Money (VFM) learn how to provide a clear framework for services delivery. We'll explore:

- examples, processes, stakeholder and staff consultations
- how to interpret data, analysis and anecdotal feedback
- how VFM can be achieved
- how to evidence continuous improvement.

The Courtroom Experience – preparation and mock trial (1 day)

Build confidence in giving evidence and dealing with defence arguments. This course covers:

- pre-court case preparation (collating court bundles, getting familiar with court papers & witness statements)
- understanding court etiquette
- taking part in a mock trial using real life case studies with a barrister and solicitors
